

The Yellowstone

The Yellowstone, the "piece de resistance" of Drawknife's line of elegant, rustic game furniture. This billiard table is the finest example of our craftsmanship. A unique blend of nature's own handiwork and man's creativity truly makes each Yellowstone a ONE-OF-A-KIND work of art.

Each of the huge burl logs that make up the base are extremely rare finds. Occasionally, as with the example pictured here, we find a single burl log large enough to split in half to make both of the base pedestals. This log has a spectacular combination of a wonderfully, knotted, gnarled look on one side and a heavily, beetle-tracked look on the other giving this table a totally unique appearance from each side.



HAND-CRAFTED ONE-OF-A-KIND CREATIONS

Our process begins a few steps earlier than that of other billiard and game furniture manufacturers. When we build one of our hand-crafted, rustic items, we start with weathered, pine logs that look as though they just came out of the forests.

The first step in building one of our billiard tables is to select and grade the logs to make up a set that will match beautifully in the finished product.

Next we strip the bark off the log with the company's namesake tool, a drawknife, before fashioning the basic elements of the piece. Each log is carefully sanded and finished to best reveal the unique beauty of the grain, color and shape.



Standard – A clean-peeled or skip-peeled log with minor natural distressing, such as occasional beetle-tracking or worm holes. These are the most common logs in the forest.

Wilderness – A peeled log that includes unique, heavily-distressed areas, commonly referred to as character.

These logs are more rare than the standard logs.

Burl – Extremely rare and unusual natural, knobby and gnarled log formations – also known as knobbled pine.

Each Drawknife product is created to provide a natural work of art with a rustic elegance to enhance your home. Our "Yellowstone Collection" reflects the lifestyle and rugged beauty of mountain living.

BAR FURNITURE

Our rolling, rustic bar, combined with our pub tables and bar stools, coordinate with our other game room furnishings to make a complete game and family room. All pieces can be ordered with the same degree of wood character and finishes to create a unique ensemble for any home.

Bar

Stock this attractive bar with your favorite snacks and beverages, then get ready for an evening of family fun or an elaborate party. However you use it, our rustic bar offers a lovely serving area for your gathering.

The back includes doors for a more finished look. The interior can be customized for an additional charge to meet your individual needs.

Pub Tables

These tables are 42" tall with 30" diameter tops. The pedestal base can be ordered to match the wood character in other items such as our billiard tables. Shown are examples of the Wilderness style, (left), with its additional half-log trim under the top and the Standard style with its clean, simple lines.

Barstools

Our barstools are offered in two models: (1.) a basic swivel seat (above, right) that can be upholstered or finished in a round wood seat, and (2.) a half-log, non-swivel seat version (right). Both are 30" high and can be finished to match other pieces.

BILLIARD TABLES

Our billiard tables are all crafted with the same quality workmanship as our other products. Styles range from the Targhee with its clean, simple lines to the Firehole shown with its unique burl accents. As with our other items, you have a choice of wood character for most of the models.

All of our tables are constructed from Lodgepole pine from the surrounding Teton forests and are available in a variety of stains to complement other furniture in your home. We offer a range of colors from a clear finish up to darker colors such as walnut.

We use 1", three-piece, backed slate for a smooth, level playing surface and offer a variety of felt colors to complement our table designs. Purchasers may also select from three pocket styles, Fringed, Plain Shield or Faux Weave Shield, in three colors, Light, Medium or Chocolate Brown. Custom pockets are available for an additional charge.

Our Wilderness Madison, Bitterrroot and Firehole tables are shown with our Drawknife Custom pockets which are made especially for us. They are available in Light Brown, Medium Brown or Dark Chocolate Brown. Contact your dealer for pricing.

Our billiard tables are built in four lengths, 7', 8', Pro 8 and 9', all of which are built to meet the standards of the Billiard Congress of America. The 8' length is the most popular size for most residential game rooms. The Pro 8 and 9' sizes are often used for tournament play. We also build snooker tables, contact your dealer for pricing.



Targhee

This is our most basic table, but one that offers the same rustic look as our other billiard tables. It includes log trim aprons and cross bars on each end to add interest to the overall design. The top rails include round mother-of-pearl sights. (Rug provided by Davies Reid, Jackson, WY)



Lone Star (below)

A variation of the Glacier, this model features six distinctive five-pointed stars that are reminiscent of designs out of the old west. As with the Glacier, the design accents and legs may be stained in a contrasting color. This table also includes "star" sights in the rails, fashioned from a dark cocabola wood, to add to the overall western look.

This lovely table includes a deeper body, accented by six beetle-tracked diamonds that may be stained in a contrasting color. The log legs may also be stained in the contrasting color to enhance the beauty of the design.

Madison Series

This is our most popular group of tables. Although each is shown in a different stain color, any of them can be stained in a variety of colors. The Standard and Alpine models come with round mother-of-pearl rail sights while the Wilderness includes stylized diamond sights in a beautiful, dark, cocabola wood.




Standard (above)

A plain-peeled log model with a vertical baluster detail on the trestle base. The simplicity of design combined with a Golden Oak finish makes this an elegant choice.


Alpine (below)


With a custom-coped, angled baluster base, reminiscent of an Alpine cottage design, this version of the Madison table has a distinctive appearance. It is shown here finished in our rich Special Walnut stain.





Bitterroot - With and without Artwork This table with its vertical log-trimmed body and apron is offered in two styles. The basic style, without artwork, is a simple rustic design. The Artwork version has custom, etched copper art inset in the sides and ends of the body. Custom plasma cut iron artwork and laser art created on wood is also available for an additional charge.





Firehole (below)

An elegant, but simple design gives the Firehole a true rustic elegance. Shown in the Burl style, this Firehole features a rare assemblage of hard-to-find burl accents and medallions. This beautiful table is an exceptional combination of man's craftsmanship and nature's unique art. The Firehole design is also available in Standard and Wilderness models.

Gallatin (above)

This is our most traditional table with a design that can bring rustic elegance to almost any décor. Each leg of the Gallatin is paneled on all four sides – giving this table a distinctive three-dimensional appearance. The inset vertical rectangles in the legs are detailed with beetle-tracked quarter-round log trim, stained in a contrasting color to enhance the design.

Madison Wall Rack (left)

Designed to hold eight cues, this wall rack features a handy compartment with a flip-down door to store such accessories as the table brush, chalk and tip maintenance supplies.

Gallatin Cue Stand (below)

A new addition to our cue stands is this one, designed to match the distinctive Gallatin billiard table. Like our other cue stands, this one holds eight cues.



Firehole Cue Stand (right)

Our cue stands hold eight cues and are available in the Standard, Wilderness and Burl log embellishments to compliment our billiard tables.

Glacier Wall Rack (not shown)
A smaller two-piece wall rack
designed to hold six cues. When
wall space is limited, this rack is a
good choice. Like all our other
companion items, it can be stained
to match any table.





Spectator Chairs (above)

These chairs offer a good view of the game while providing comfortable seating with padded, 30" high seats and smooth, contoured backs. Each chair includes two cue notches and leatherlined drink holders. Shown at right is a custom version of these chairs with the back and the seat upholstered in leather, (requires an upcharge).

They are upholstered in heavy-duty vinyl in your choice of green, brown or black. (All of our upholstered items can be done in leather, cowhide or fabric for an additional charge.)



GAME TABLES AND CHAIRS




Our newest model the Gallatin (shown above with chairs), has a distinctive three-dimensional look, with vertical insets in the legs that are detailed with beetle-tracked quarter-round log trim and stained in a contrasting color to enhance the design. The Standard (shown top center), the Wilderness (shown on page below with chairs) has an attractive, four-leg base, and the Burl model has a sturdy burl log pedestal (shown bottom center).






Side Chairs

Dartboard Cabinet
